

How we can help

- Our team at hello@yourcityyourhome.co.uk will be able to advise what tools and equipment may be available from the council or other partners at sites located around the city. This may include strong black bags, litter pickers, gloves and hi-viz vests or reflective arm bands.
- To arrange for us to collect your bagged litter you can sign up to our list of groups and individuals that take part in litter picks and have rubbish removed free of charge. Visit www.newcastle.gov.uk/envirocall 'Apply to be a Community Litter Picker'. You will need to provide a name and password for you/your group. You can then 'Request Removal of Community Litter'. A pin marks the street litter bin where you want your bagged waste to be collected from. This can only be arranged after the event. To book a bespoke collection in advance or to arrange for us to collect from a site that is not next to a street litter bin you will need to call 0191 2787878 and ask for 'bins'.
- Litter will only be collected on Monday – Thursday (9am – 3pm) and Friday (9am - 12pm). Please note we are unable to separate recycling from general litter as the bags will be collected along with general street litter bin waste. Any litter collected at weekends or on public holidays will have to be safely stored until we are able to arrange for collection.
